#### Special Awards

Over the last couple of months, the school has been working hard to recognise and celebrate the work that goes on each day to ensure our children can be the best they can be. I have listed below two awards that we are proud to have achieved. Inclusion Quality Mark provides schools with a nationally recognised framework to guide their inclusion journey. The IQM team help schools evaluate and measure how they are performing; empowering them to improve and grow. And when they're successful, IQM recognise their achievement through a system of highly valued awards that provide external validation of their inclusive status. There are over 5,500 schools in the UK who have either received an IQM Inclusive School Award, or are actively working towards meeting the standard required.
